

Regulations on Master Degree Examination

Department of Applied Mathematics, National Sun Yat-sen University

Applicable to students admitted in and after Fall, 2015

Article 1

The following regulations are in accordance with the Law of Academic Degree Conferment and its enforcement rules promulgated by MOE and NSYSU Academic Regulations, Implementation bylaws for Ph.D. and Master Degree Examination and related ordinances.

Article 2 Ordinances during study

2-1 The period of study is 1 to 4 years based on the regulations of MOE (admission retention and deferment years are excluded).

2-2 Credits and Course Requirement

2-2-1 Seminar I and Seminar II are compulsory courses.

2-2-2 To fulfill graduation requirement, students shall obtain 30 credits. A minimum of 24 credits shall be courses of lecture forms including at least 18 credits conducted by The Department of Applied Mathematics. A student must obtain consent from his/her supervisor (or advisor) and the chairman of his/her department before selecting a course.

2-2-3 According to the NSYSU Guidelines for Course on Academic Ethics, Students must complete the academic ethics course in the first academic year, or they are not allowed to take the Master Degree Examination.

2-3 Designation of Academic Advisor

Students shall find their own academic advisors and file their choices with the department before the end of the first semester. The consent from the chairman of the department is required when academic advisors are not full-time faculty of the department.

Article 3 Master Degree Examination

3-1 Students who fail the degree examination within the period of study can take another exam once. Students who fail the second exam will be suspended based on the NSYSU regulations.

3-2 Students shall submit thesis following the University format and two hard copies of the complete thesis to the department after thesis defense. The thesis should be written in English..

Article 4 Graduation: Application for graduation may be submitted when the regulations above are met.

Article 5 The bylaw will be implemented after approval of the meetings of the Department of Applied Mathematics and the College of Science and obtaining signature of President. Any modification of the bylaw will go through the same procedure.

In case of discrepancy between the Chinese version of terms & rules and its English translation, the Chinese version shall prevail.
